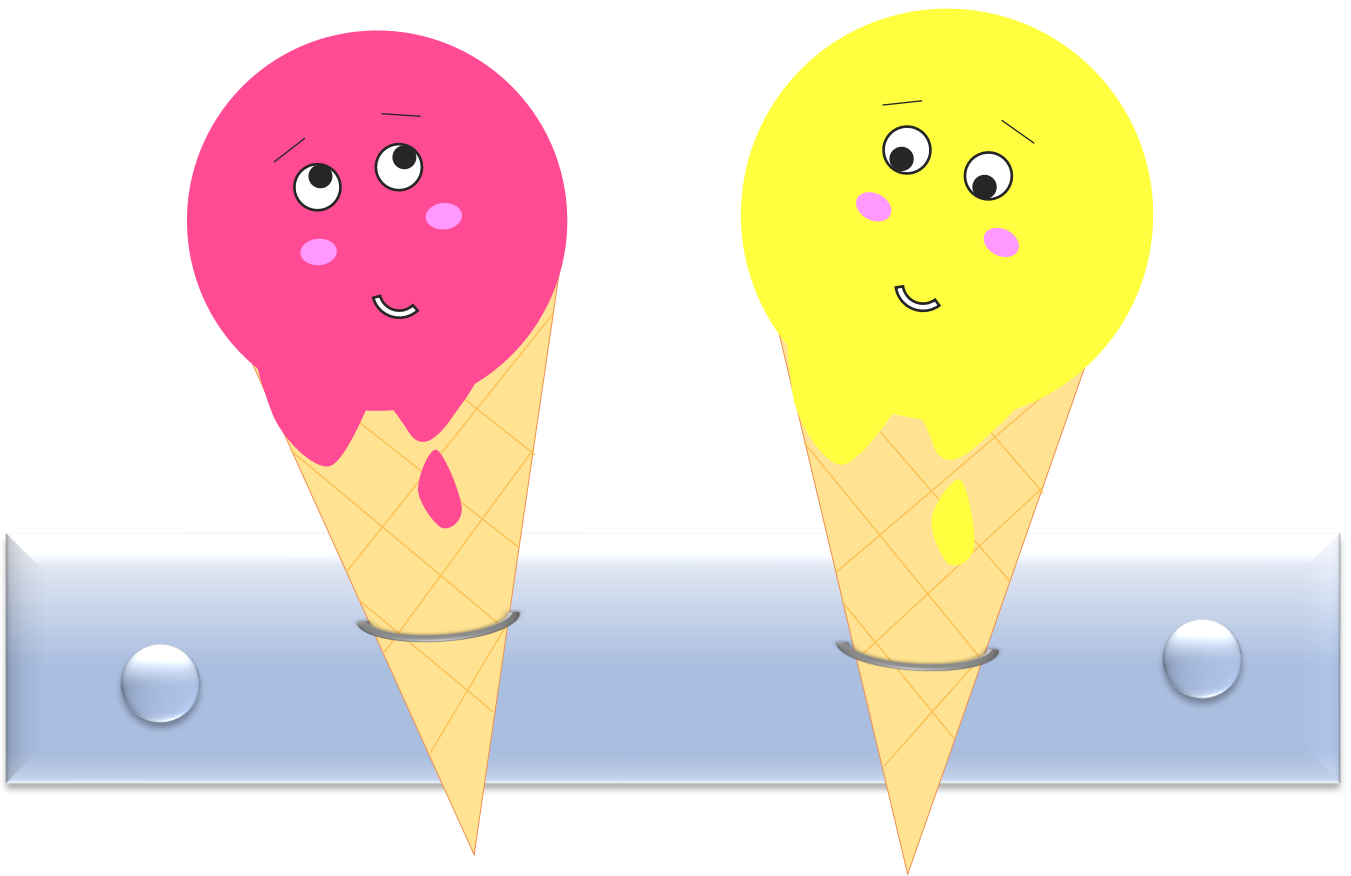
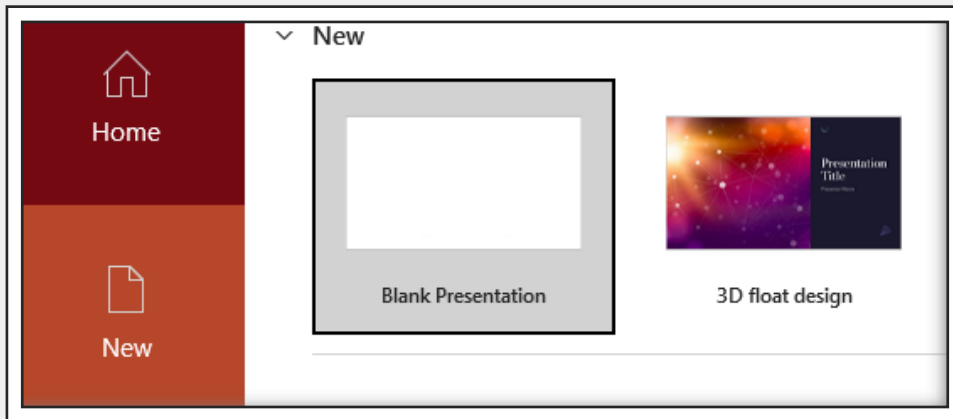


How to Create a Cute Ice Cream Clipart in PPTX

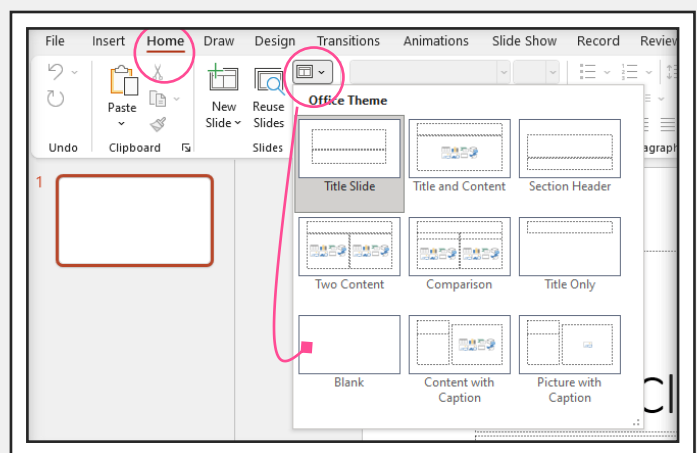
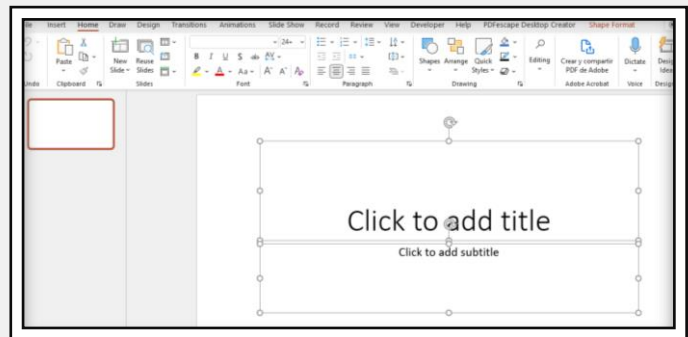


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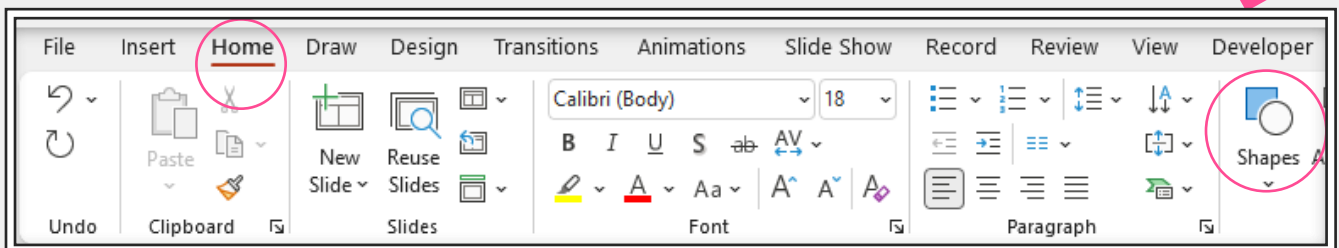
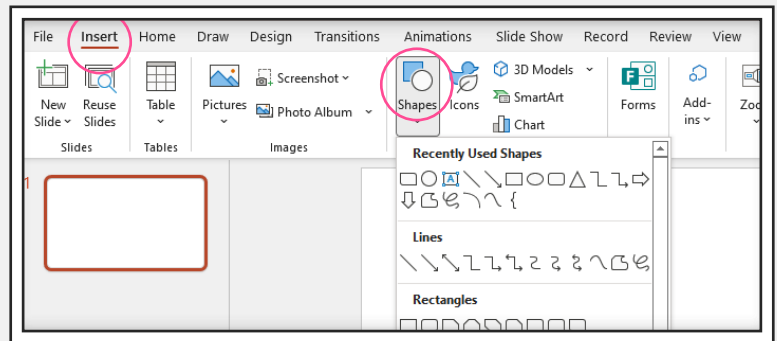
Open your PowerPoint. Select the blank presentation to start.



By default it will open a presentation slide where we can click to add a title, since we want a blank canvas to work with, we will get rid of it by selecting it with the mouse and removing it with the delete key. You can also go to home, select slide layout, and then choose blank.



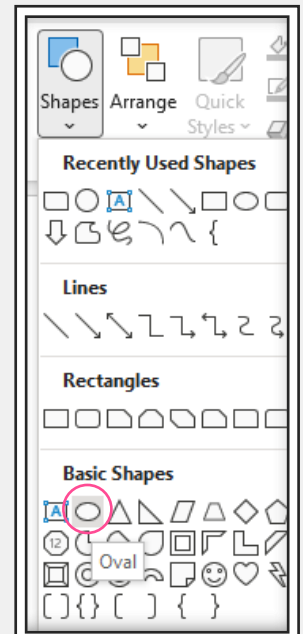
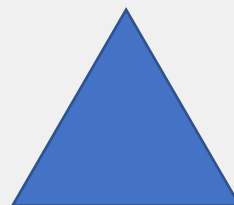
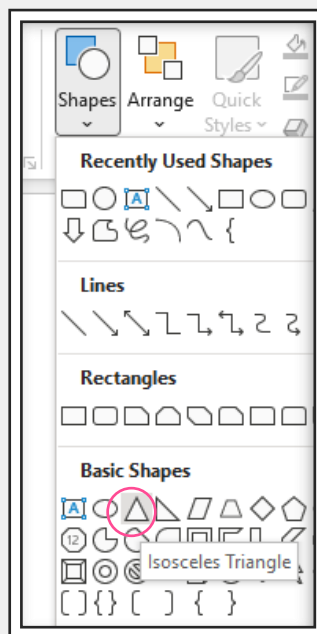
Now from the home or insert tab in the ribbon, go to shapes to insert a triangle and an oval.



You have two options here:

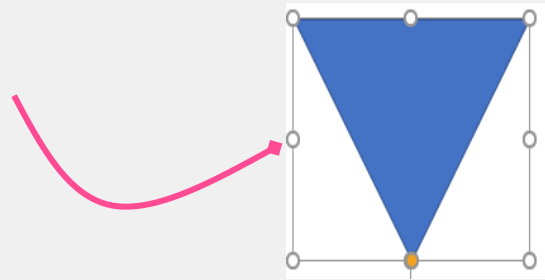
1) Click on the oval and drag it wherever you want to, pressing the shift key at the same time so you can control the size of it and keep its shape.

2) Click on the oval, drag it, by default it will already be a circle, to increase or decrease the size without losing the perfect circle shape, press shift while taking the circle from one of the corners (white dots).



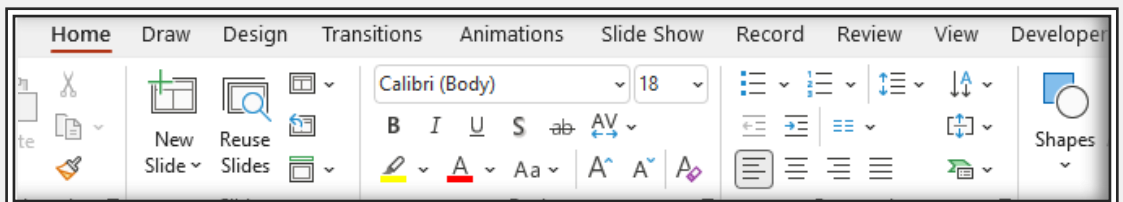
Now follow the same steps to insert the triangle.

Rotate the triangle and give it the right shape by picking the little white dot on the side. In this case you want to narrow it to give it the cone shape.

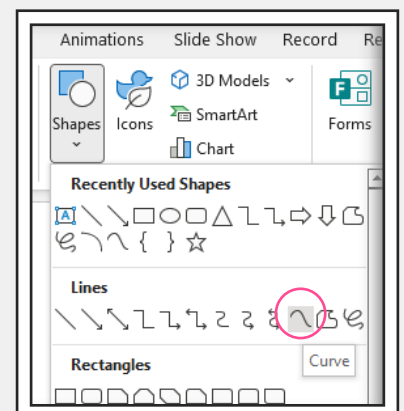
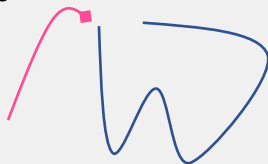


Now place the circle on top of the "cone" to create the ice cream ball.

Go to shape, select the curve tool, to create the "melting" effect. You have to play with it, until you have the shape you want and close the shape by clicking near the starting point. I've created 2 shapes, but you can have fun with it!



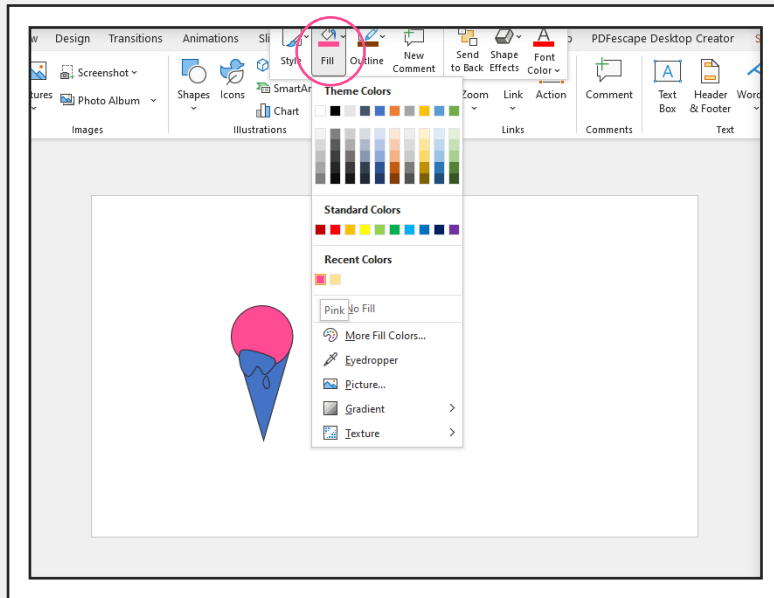
You have to close the shape by clicking near the starting point.



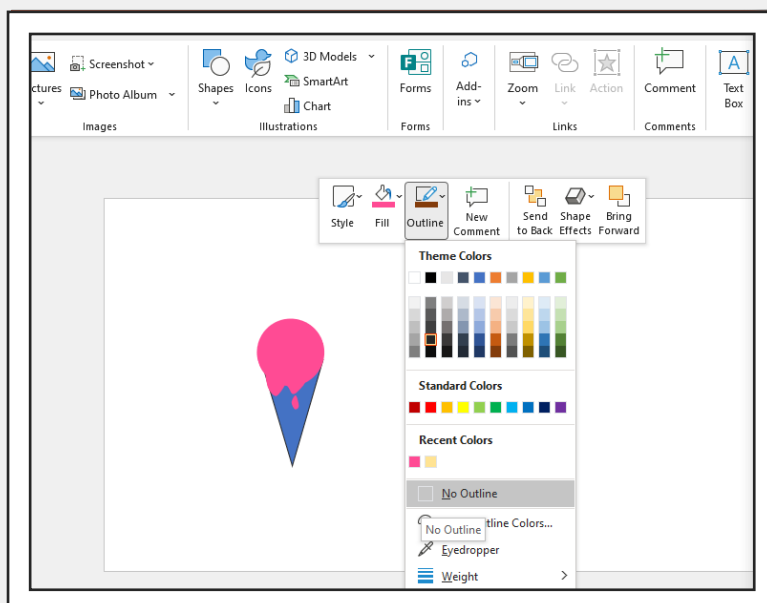
Now take the shapes that you have made with the curve tool and place them in the ball to create the melting effect.

Change the color

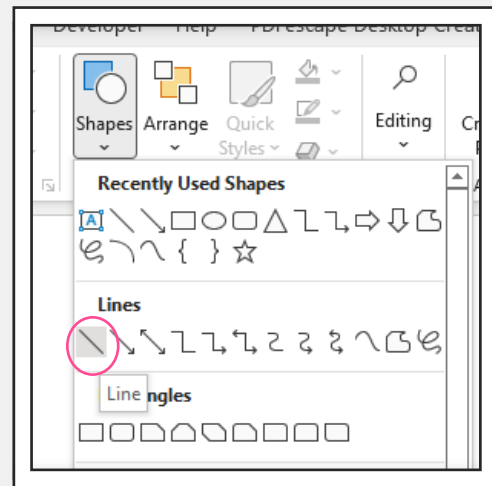
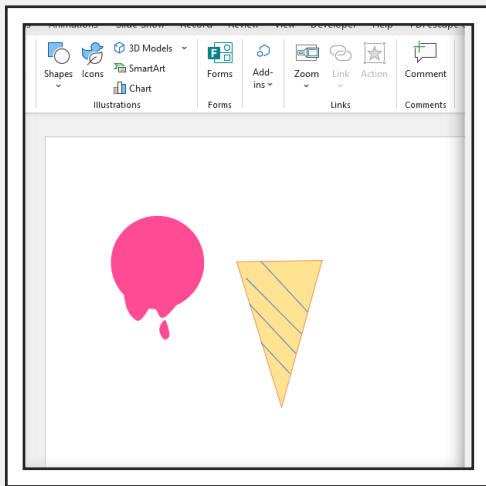
Place the mouse on the shape of which you want to change the color. Right click on it, go to the fill tool, pick your color. Do the same with the “melting” shape and drop.



Now right click on it again, click outline, select no outline. Do the same steps to color the cone, but this time you can pick a color for the outline.

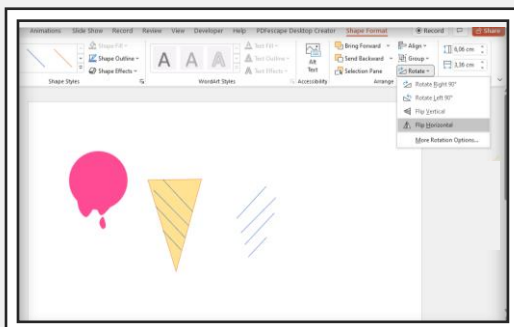
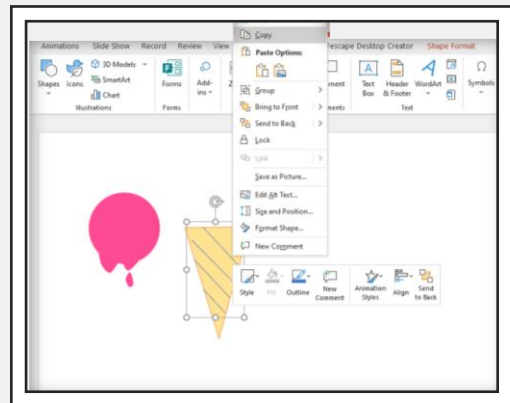
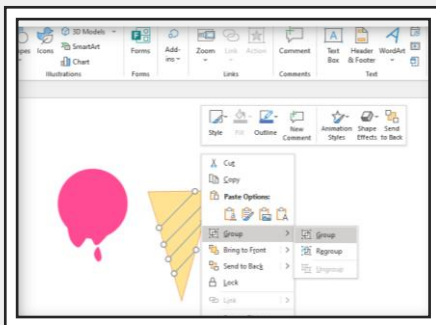


Before inserting the lines, group the ball and the melting effect, select them, right click, group, so you can move it to insert the lines in the cone. I will insert 4 vertical lines in the cone, but you could insert more of course. In the ribbon, go to home or insert tab and select shapes and then lines.



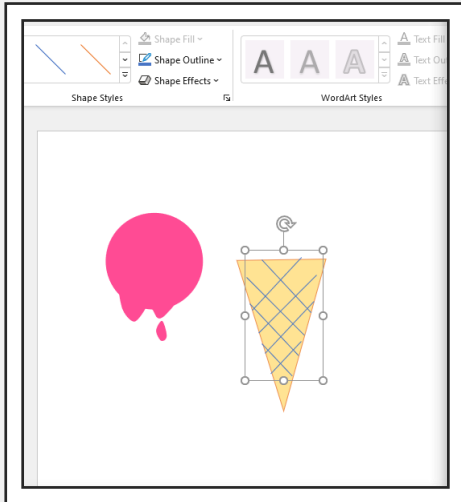
Duplicate the lines, rotate, place them!

Group the lines. Select them with the mouse, right click, group.

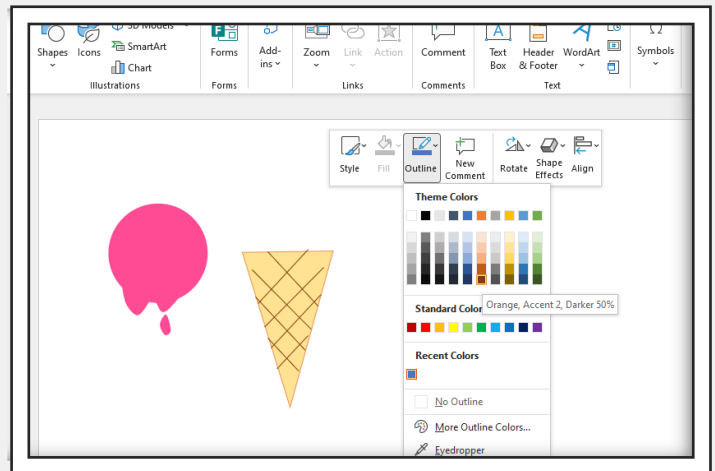


Copy and paste the lines somewhere in your work space and rotate them (right click on it, shape format, rotate, flip horizontally).

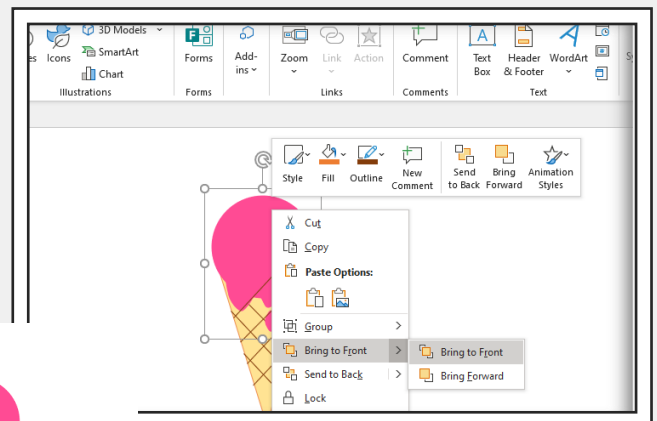
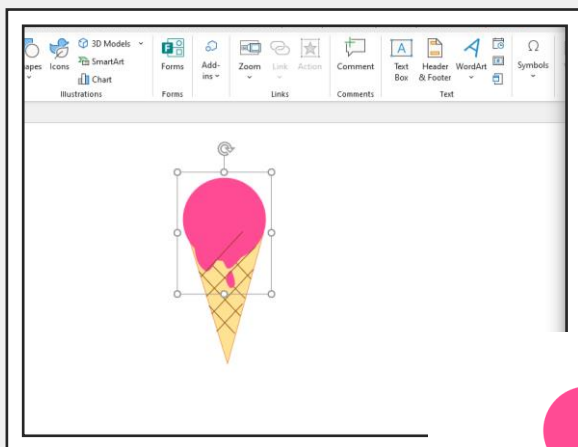
Take the rotated lines and place them on top of the other lines that are already in the cone.



Select the lines, right click to change the color using the outline tool.



You will notice the lines are in front of the ice cream ball. To change that, bring the ice cream ball to front (select it, right click, bring it to front).

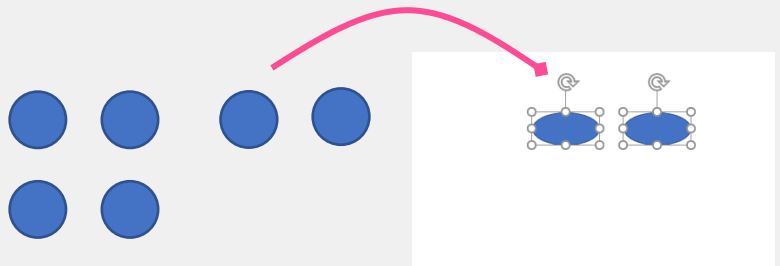
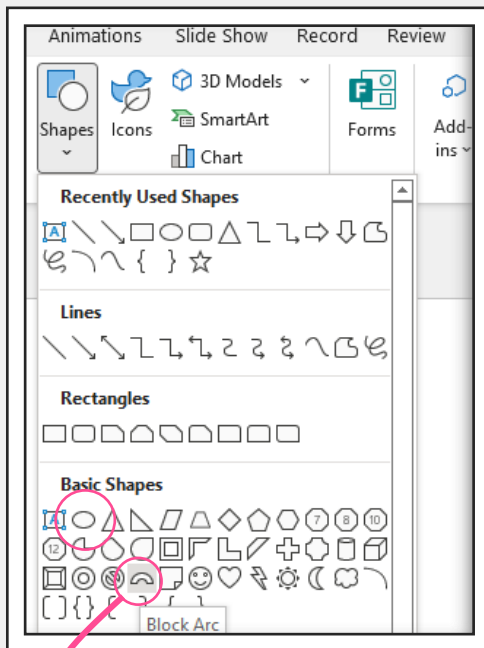


Let's have fun creating the cute face.

This is how I do it, but feel free to create your own style.

We need to insert 6 circles (you can insert one and copy and paste the rest). Go to home, shapes and select the oval, remember to insert them pressing the shift key.

Now take two of these circles from one of the corners (white dots) without pressing the shift key this time, to form an oval that you will use to create the cheeks and with the rest of circles you will form the eyes.



Now insert two lines (eyebrows) and the block arc shape (mouth) and just have fun positioning the shapes to form a cute face.

Then color the eyes, cheeks and mouth, following the same steps we did to color the ice cream.



Last but not least, remember that you have a video (without voice-over) that you can watch while following this guide. I hope you like it and you find some value in it. 😊
