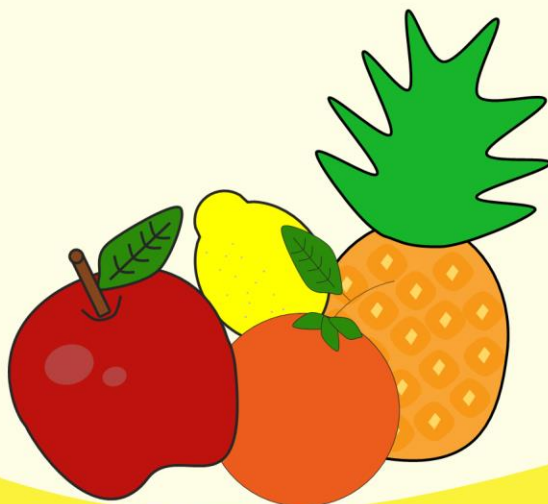

Print all the puzzle pieces on cardstock, cut them out and mix them all up. Now the little ones have to match the fruits with their names in English and Spanish.

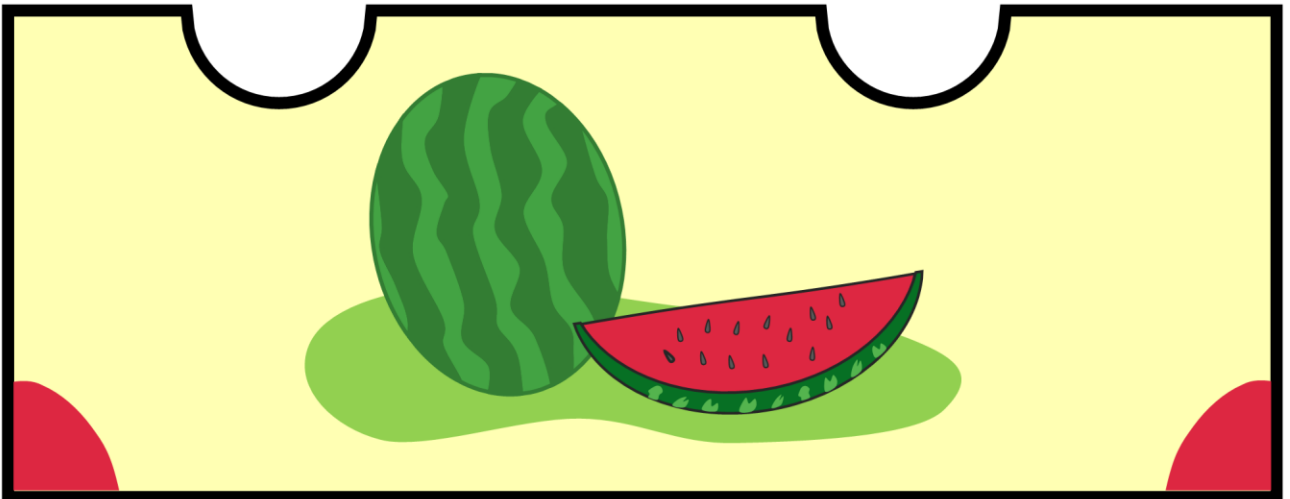
I have included a color and black and white version with the names on it as well as a black and white version without the names so you can use it as a writing activity.

Although, there are other ways to say it too, but I think these two are the most commonly used.

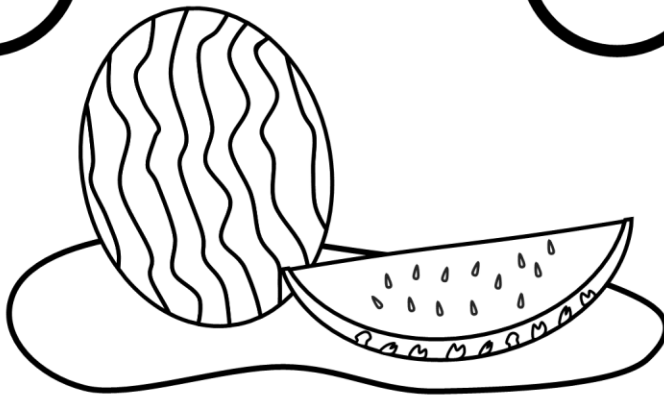
